# School to seek bids for demolition

## Of all or part of T. H. Jenkins campus

Since no bids were received for the sale of the T. H. Jenkins campus, members of the McGregor School Board voted to seek bids for demolition of all or part of the campus built in the 1950's.

Superintendent Kevin Houchin reported that the campus is currently being used by TSTC, MCC Connections and the Gloryland Church. He added that enrollment for the TSTC classes is small.

"What impact will the demolition have for MCC Connections?" Board Member Carolyn Lillard asked.

Supt. Houchin responded by saying, "The district has furnished a place for MCC Connections for several years to help provide for the educational needs of the community. I've spoken to the City of McGregor about hosting the program again."

Another possibility given by the superintendent was to place them in the classroom portion of

the gymnasium at the T. H. Jenkins campus if that building is not demolished.

Another motion was made and passed to give the entities currently using the T. H. Jenkins campus 60 days notice to vacate the facility.

In other business the board approved a band trip to Orlando, Florida in June of 2010.

During the discussion Board member Carolyn Lillard encouraged planning for educational trips when going out of state rather than trips to amusement parks, citing closer opportunities in Texas for trips to amusement parks.

"In my discussions with Band Director Paul Fullerton, he said retention of band members is the main purpose for scheduling out of state trips. He pointed out that retention of juniors and seniors hasn't been good for the last two years. The band would be conducting a performance during

the trip."

The board approved contracts for Jody Steed as a kindergarten teacher, Kimberly Canion as a second grade teacher, Lyn Linkous as an elementary life skills teacher, and Kyle Schoppach as a teacher/coach.

Trustees also accepted the resignations of Bob Balshaw and Toni Kienbaum.

Concerning electronic devices, Assistant Superintendent James Lenamon gave a brief report on the policies.

"Most of the districts have a policy that is similar to that of McGregor ISD," Lenamon said. "Cell phones are taken up when used at inappropriate times. Most of the districts, however, charge the state maximum fine of \$15 when they return the phone."

Supt. Houchin reported that the new bleachers are being installed at the high school gymnasium and should be ready for use at graduation.

Bids are being sought for renovation of the lighting and ceiling in the Sixth Grade Annex at the H. G. Isbill school.

A public hearing for use of federal funds and American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Funds was postponed.

Under the superintendent's report plans were finalized for the Summer Leadership Training Conference.

Supt. Houchin reported that in a 41/42 Partnership, Northwest ISD has agreed to purchase about \$575,000 of WADA from McGregor ISD.

Board member Jim Bates on behalf of the board offered congratulations to Lisa Carpenter and her art students for their Art Show last Sunday afternoon and for another highly successful year at contests.

## McGregor pool marks 50th year

The McGregor ISD is receiving competitive sealed proposals for ceiling and lighting renovations for a classroom addition at the H. G. Isbill Junior High School. The scope of the work in each of six classrooms includes demo of existing grid and installing new ceiling grid, installing new 2X2 ceiling tile, furnishing and installing 6" of insulation, refurbishing all existing light fixtures with new ballasts and new bulbs, and furnishing and installing one new emergency light. Hallway and bathroom renovations include furnishing and installing new ceiling grid, installing new 2X2 ceiling tile, furnishing and installing 6" of insulation, furnishing and installing two 2X4 lay in lights and one emergency light in each restroom, and furnishing and installing twelve 2X4 lay in lights and four emergency lights in the hallway. 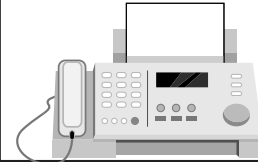

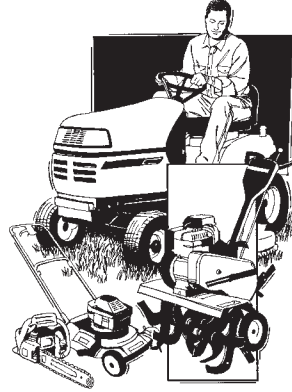

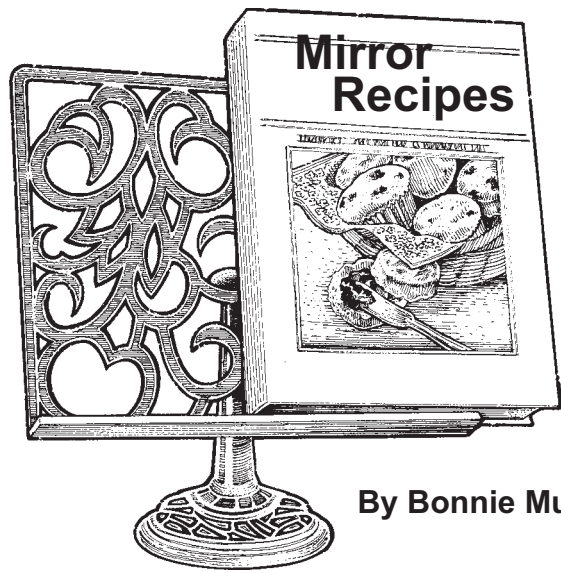

# Graduation— recipes for gatherings

This weekend will bring together families and friends — celebrating milestones in their families' lives — graduations, and some will be celebrating the first weekend of summer.

It will be a time for firing up the grills. You might be hosting the gathering or taking a dish to someone else's party. Here are a few recipe ideas that would be perfect for any party table. . .

done. Drain excess liquid. Serve with spicy dipping sauce.

### SPICY DIPPING SAUCE

- 1/2 cup catsup
  - 1/2 cup brown sugar
  - 1/4 cup cider vinegar
  - 1 T. Worcestershire sauce
  - 2 tsp. hot sauce
  - 1 tsp salt
  - 1 tsp. Accent
  - 1/2 tsp. dry mustard
  - 1/4 tsp. pepper
  - 1/4 tsp. liquid smoke
  - 2 T. finely chopped onion
- Combine all ingredients in a small saucepan. Bring mixture to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer 15 minutes.

### PARTY PIGGIES

- 2 cups apple jelly
  - 1 cup barbecue sauce
  - 1/3 cup mustard
  - 1 (3-pound) package smoked cocktail sausage
- Combine apple jelly, barbecue sauce and mustard in a large saucepan. Bring mixture to a rolling boil. Add sausage. Simmer over low heat 1 hour.

### PARTY MEATBALLS

- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 cup seasoned bread crumbs
- 2 T. finely chopped onions
- 1 T finely chopped green onions

- 1 clove garlic (minced)
- 2 T. barbecue sauce
- 1 tsp. horseradish
- 2 eggs (slightly beaten)
- 3/4 tsp Creole seasoning
- 2 T. gated Parmesan cheese
- 1/3 cup olive oil

Combine all ingredients, except olive oil. Mix thoroughly. Form into 1-inch meatballs. Brown meatballs in hot oil until

done. You can alternate sauce by combining 1 (12-ounce) bottle chili sauce, 1 (10-ounce) jar grape jelly and 1/4 cup white wine.

### CONFETTI DIP

- Cook in double boiler until thick:
  - 1 tsp butter
  - 1 T. vinegar
  - 1 T. sugar
  - 2 eggs beaten
- Remove from heat and cool. Whip until creamy.
- Add:
- One 8 oz. package cream cheese and beat again until creamy. Add following ingredients, chopped fine.
  - 1 small jar pimientos
  - 1 small green pepper
  - 1 small onion
  - 1 tsp. Tabasco sauce (more or less as desired)
- Salt to taste and whip again. Serve with any kind of chips or crackers.

### TEX-MEX DIP

- 2 bunches chopped scallions/green onions
  - 3 medium ripe avocados with 1/4 cup Miracle Whip
  - 2 T. lemon juice
  - 1/2 tsp. salt (garlic w/parsley)
  - 1/4 tsp. Tabasco or pepper
  - 1 cup (8 oz) sour cream
  - 1/2 cup salad dressing or mayo
  - 1 pkg. (1 1/8 oz) small Taco serving (Lawry's is best)
  - 2 cans (10 1/2 oz. each) bean dip
  - 2 medium tomatoes peeled, seeded and chopped
  - 2 cans (3 oz. each) ripe olive, chopped
  - 1 (8 oz.) pkg. sharp cheddar cheese
  - 1 large pkg. or more tortilla chips
- Peel, pit, mash avocados with lemon juice, garlic, salt and pepper. Combine sour cream, mayo and taco seasoning mix. Spread bean dip on large serving platter with 1/4 cup Miracle Whip. Top with avocado mixture (to which I add about 1/4 cup salad dressing).

Layer with sour cream/taco mixture. Sprinkle with chopped onion, tomatoes, olives/mixed if you wish). Cover with shredded cheese. Serve chilled or at room temperature.

### SMOKED BBQ BRISKET

- This brisket is even better if it stays in your refrigerator a day after cooking to absorb the flavors. Slice and reheat it in the oven before serving.
- 1 (4 to 6 lb.) beef brisket, trimmed
  - 1 (5-oz.) bottle liquid smoke
  - 1 onion, chopped
  - 2 tsp. garlic salt
  - 1 to 2 tsp. salt
  - 1/3 cup Worcestershire sauce
  - 1 (12-18 oz.) bottle barbecue sauce
- Place brisket in a large shallow dish or extra-large zip-top freezer bag; pour liquid smoke over brisket. Sprinkle evenly with onion, garlic salt and salt. Cover or seal, and chill 8 hours, turning occasionally. Remove brisket and place on a large piece of heavy-duty aluminum foil, discarding liquid smoke mixture. Pour Worcestershire sauce evenly over brisket, and fold foil to seal; place wrapped brisket in a roasting pan.
- Bake at 275 degrees F. for 5 hours. Unfold foil; pour barbecue sauce evenly over brisket in a roasting pan. Bake 1 more hour, uncovered.

### OVERNIGHT CHICKEN CASSEROLE

- 1 (12-inch) loaf sour dough bread
- 1 T. butter
- 1 1/2 cups finely chopped onion
- 1/4 cup finely chopped green onion
- 1/4 cup finely chopped green pepper
- 5 chicken breasts (cooked and chopped)
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1 T. instant chicken bouillon granules
- 2 tsp. Creole seasoning

- 3/4 tsp. pepper
  - 4 eggs (beaten)
  - 3 cups milk
  - 1 (10 3/4 ounce) can cream of mushroom soup
  - 1 cup grated Cheddar cheese
- Freeze bread for 30 minutes. Remove and cut into 1/2 inch cubes. Layer 1/2 bread in a large greased baking dish.
- Saute' onions and green pepper in butter until vegetables are tender. (Do not brown.) Stir in chicken, mayonnaise, bouillon, and seasonings. Spoon mixture over bread cubes. Layer remaining bread over mixture. Combine eggs and milk. Whisk to blend thoroughly. Pour liquid over casserole. Cover with tight-fitting lid. Refrigerate overnight. Uncover to bake. Bake at 350 degrees for 15 minutes. Spread soup over casserole. Bake 35 minutes. Sprinkle with cheese. Bake additional 10 minutes.

### LEMON BARS

Makes 3 to 4 dozen  
For the dough:

- 2 cups sifted flour
  - 1 cup butter, softened
  - 1/2 cup sifted powdered sugar
- For the lemon filling:
- 4 eggs
  - 2 cups sugar
  - 6 T. lemon juice
  - 2 tsp. grated lemon zest
  - 1/4 cup flour
  - 1/4 tsp. baking powder
  - 1/4 tsp salt
  - Powdered sugar for sprinkling on top.
- Preheat oven to 325 degrees F. In a medium sized bowl, mix ingredients for the dough and pack into an ungreased 9 x 13-inch baking dish. Bake 20 minutes. In another mixing bowl, beat eggs lightly. Add sugar, lemon juice and zest. Sift flour, baking powder and salt into egg mixture and beat. Pour over dough layer as soon as it comes out from the oven. Increase oven temperature to 350 degrees F. Bake another 20 minutes. Sprinkle with powdered sugar, cool and then cut into squares.

### JUNE 7, 1929—

McGregor schools had their closing ceremony with the graduation of the 1929 class of seniors. Loraine Scuggs was the class valedictorian and Inez Holloway was salutatorian.

- Graduates from the East McGregor High School were Hillary Pleasant, Annelaa Lewis, Johnnie Thomas, Lillie Mae Thomas, Osceola Smith, Chorcie Mae Washington.
- Miss Ane Johnson married Albert N. Davenport.

### JUNE 2, 1939—

- V.G. (Slim) Rich bought A.W. Hering Grocery and took over on June 1, changing the name to the V.G. (Slim) Rich Grocery and Market.

- "Stagecoach" starring John Wayne and "King of the Underworld" starring Humphrey Bogart were features at The Ritz.

- Miss Louise Cooper and J.W. Boren were the top two MHS graduates. Other honor students for the Class of 1939 were Leita McLeod, Mary Lou Turner, Martha Williams, Buford Hitt and Walton Fulp.

### MAY 27, 1949—

- The McGregor Chamber of Commerce and McGregor Garden Club joined forces in a beautification project by having a Most Improved Premises contest. Winners shared \$80 in prize money. Top winner was Lillie and Elvin Cox.

- Twenty-six of the 35 member 1924 MHS Class returned for a reunion. Members included Garth Lynn, Rufus Elliott, Frances Crain Lyons, Agnes Brandt Forebih, Myrtle Brandon Heath, Willa Mae Cross Smith, Ruby Barnard Knauth, Gena Grantham Isbill, Tom Edrington, Terry Graham, Robert Foster Cherry, Lucille Morrison Walters, Jesse B. Brown, Mack Smith, Frances Connally Bailey, Tom D. Bailey, Floss Brown Fason, Robert Green, Jim Crews, Walter Witte, Robert Bailey Dowis, Mrs. Klyce

Allen, Hoyle E. Hackney, Elbert H. Duncan, Mr. and Mrs. Joe L. Allen and Mrs. Lucile Wheat.

### MAY 29, 1959—

- McGregor's new \$25,000 swimming pool opened Friday. The main pool was 82.5 feet long and spanned from 30 feet wide on the diving end to 50 feet on the shallow end. Depth ranged from three feet to 10 feet. The wading pool was 10 x 20 feet. A fully equipped concession stand was located on the southside of the dressing rooms and opened onto a fenced eating area which was equipped with tables and umbrellas. The community was invited to the grand opening and dedication service. The event brought to fruition almost a year of planning, fund-raising and construction. The ribbon was cut by Barbara Maupin, who had recently won KCEN-TV's Miss Versatility Contest. Representatives from all the civic groups and organizations that helped, stood by.

Coach Norman Smith was the pool manager. His staff included Mrs. Lee Ardell, Mrs. Billy Swoveland and lifeguards Jack Gibson and Arlin Braun.

- Tom Britton was the top eighth grade student with a GPA of 96.80.

- Winning first place medals in twirling were Lynda White, Betty Lou Upchurch, Natishua Mote and Beverly Collins in high school. Junior high twirlers receiving firsts were Linda Hudson and Barbara Owens.

### MAY 31, 1969—

- Four MHS Class of 1969 graduates were presented with scholarships that totaled \$775. Recipients were Layne Kruse, Linda Allen, Gary Pennington and Charles Holder.

- McGregor telephone customers voted in a straw poll overwhelmingly in favor of the proposed metropolitan service linking them to Waco without long distance charges by voting 781 for and 212 against.

- Miss Linda Shofner married G.J. Jacks.

- Miss Betty Ann Wendt became the bride of S.P. Zimmerman.

### MAY 24, 1979—

- McGregor School Board hired three teachers. Mrs. Elaine Douba would teach junior high math, Mrs. Carol Armstrong was hired to teach first grade and Mrs. Melba Gailey would teach English in the high school and junior high.

- In a special meeting, the City of McGregor voted to participate in the Bluebonnet Water Supply Corporation.

- OHS valedictorian was Dewayne Mooneyham and Arnold Ramsey was salutatorian.

### JUNE 1, 1989—

- After a year of on and off negotiations, the McGregor City Council agreed to a contract with Central Bosque Water Supply Corporation. The contract was for one million gallons of water per month, take or pay, with a three million gallon maximum. Water would be priced same as Midway of \$1.40 per thousand gallons.

- MHS Class of 1969 met for their 20th Class Reunion. Attending were David Lofland, Lanny Patterson, Charles Mooney, David Anderson, Bob Bounds, Janet Berryhill, Kathy Rudolf, Linda Wagnon, Shelly Crouch, Carla Turner, Bill Bounds, Sharon Turbeville, Stan Spitzer, Gary Pennington, Paula Wilson and Shirley Brumley.

### MAY 27, 1999—

- 120 MOC seniors graduated as the Classes of 1999. Amber Wendt was MHS Class Valedictorian and Salutatorian was Shamika Smith. CHS Class Valedictorian was Paul Matthies. OHS Valedictorian was Matt Storrs and Salutatorian was Brandon Ross.

- Crawford Baseball Coach Ronnie Bruce was named Coach of the Year in District 23AA and Eddy Dieterich was named as

Most Valuable Player of the district. Named to first team from Crawford were Josh Smith, James Irwin, Justin Henson. Second team selections were Eric Armstrong, Blair Beatty. Honorable Mentions included Jordan Westerfeld, Daniel Bruce and Russell Christian.

- Another pool season was to open with Larry Oliver, Jr serv-

ing as manager. Lifeguards were Heath Tullous, Brandon Luedeker, Sam Bell, Meghan Mullens and Christy Leos.

- Junior High Spirit Award Winners at the Academic Banquet were Freddie Rollins and Tammy Lillard.

- Four Lady Bulldogs made the All Star Baseball Team—Lindsay Shannon, Jeanette

Bickford, Veronica Owens and Brandi Michalewicz.

"Can't I even speak?"*

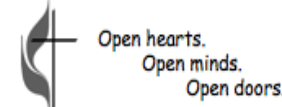
